It was Friday evening and we were opening the Sabbath. We got our loud speaker and started song service and then a sermon opening the Sabbath and we welcomed the clan for the service tomorrow. We were three speakers and a number of youths who were going house to house distributing our literature. We also had adults who were assisting in food preparation. Our program was to have all the morning hours spent in Bible study and then visiting people in their homes, where we then invited them to come to our meeting. And in the afternoon we had public meeting in the open air, from 2.00 o'clock to 5.00 o'clock. Again from 7.15 we had another meeting where we were teaching, now using a slide show with a projector. We had PowerPoint lessons of the sanctuary and prophecy, with latest of world events. After each lesson a call was made, for anyone that may have made a decision to follow Jesus. And in every call two or three could be found who were welcome to the front and we prayed for them and their names were taken so that a follow-up could be arranged. We realized that many people were attending the evening lessons from 7.15 up to 9.00 p.m. People liked these night lessons because they could see the slides on the projector. Others feared attending day time for fear of their leaders, while others were busy at during working hours. For two weeks we presented this subject clearly.

1. Prophecy. The book of Daniel and Revelation was opened to people clearing Daniel chapters 2, 7, 8, 9 and Revelation Chapters 2 and 3 where we covered the church History and Chapter 7 and 8. We spoke about the sealing and then we were able to cover chapters 12, 13, 14, 17 and 18. When chapters 17 and 18 were presented, many people made a decision to come and join the true church, especially when they learned who the Harlot woman riding a beast was and that she was a mother of harlots. That is when they saw that their churches were daughters of Babylon. Then as we moved to 18 and made a call to separate from Babylon many came to the front and this is the day we saw a big number accepting the truth.
2. We also taught the Sanctuary message and it helped us when we were explaining the anti-Christ and we showed them the worship service as God directed the children of Israel and our time.
3. We had health lessons with a cooking class. We taught people how to cook healthful food and how to treat diseases with natural remedies.

The Sabbath was clearly presented as the seal of God when we were teaching about the Decalogue of the Ten Commandment of God.

Now at the end of the two weeks which was on Sabbath, we had altogether 58 souls who accepted Christ as their personal savior. Out of this number 27 were baptized yesterday; those who had been attending the Bible study with the Bible

workers, while the rest are enrolled in Baptismal class to be baptized after they complete the course. Of the 27 members some were SDA's who had backslidden. We were able to distribute 34 King James Bibles to those who had none, especially those who were baptized; but the demand was big because as we entered into many homes, many people are without Bibles even those who attend their Sunday churches. **We had 89 booklets of Secret Terrorists; Desire of Ages 16 copies; 32 Bibles; Ministry of healing 12 copies and National Sunday law books; Steps to Christ 23 copies Kiswahili and English; 8 copies of great controversy and 2600 tracts of "Behold He Cometh, World crisis foretold and future facts."**



Expenditure: We spent Kshs 35,000 that is equivalent to \$443 US, to run this crusade. And also the members contributed food and other things.

We were faced with challenges from Sunday-keeping pastors who were warning their members not to come to our meeting and came around to see who was coming. And they warned their members not to invite us to their homes nor hold any Bible discussion with us. But God worked this out when we opened the lesson of health. Many people came because their health was troubling them and through this we got them and even others came who wanted to be taught how to prepare food.

In addition to the other problems, the SDA conference pastors were attacking us as they also warned members not to come to our meetings. The elders and pastors were constantly around to see who was coming to our meeting. So people feared to be put out of the church and therefore could not come boldly. Other Pentecostal churches started their meetings at the same place, which was meant to

counter our meetings. We were also disturbed with rain and we lost three lessons due to the inclement weather as we had no shelter. Other times it was early or late.

We are serving a wonderful God. He provided us with security and he was on our side. We ended up our meeting well on Sabbath with blessings.

Our request:

We are appealing to our Brethren to awake and help us with materials. We need books and tracts for distribution.

God has helped us in that we have translated the book “Patriarchs and Prophets” into a Kiswahili language, which the majority could read as this language is spoken in 6 different countries: Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Rwanda, Burundi, and Congo. With these books we will reach many souls. So this book is ready, but we are unable to print. Is there any way you can help us to print? We had previously done “Early Writings” and “Christ Object Lessons” into Kiswahili and we printed 1500 copies each.

It is our sincere prayer that there may be a way that you will help with this work.

May God bless you for your support and moral encouragement.
