Semester 3 – Week 9 - Class 17 THE UNITED STATES IN BIBLE PROPHECY

Question: Is the Bible just a history book?

Does it really describe the rise of the United States? It's important for us as <u>Bible students</u> to notice that the Bible has some history, but it is not predominately a history book. Why doesn't the Bible mention China? India? Brazil? Canada? or Poland? If it were predominately a history book, then you just have to raise the question, Why doesn't it say something about every nation?

The Bible brings to view nations that have a direct impact upon God's people. It brings to view nations that have a direct relationship to the plan of salvation.

The Bible first shows us the Garden of Eden with Adam and Eve. After the Flood and the fact that the ark came to rest on Mt. Ararat, we're taken to Ur of Chaldees with Abraham and Egypt, Palestine, Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece, Rome and Europe.

Question: Does the Bible mention the United States in prophecy? We need to turn to the book of Revelation.

Revelation 12 deals with what is called the Great Controversy between Christ and Satan.

Revelation 14 we find God's final message to mankind, as well as the Jesus' second coming.

In Revelation 13 we find that the Mark of the Beast will be strictly enforced as well as the fact that this chapter is the connecting link between the dark ages and God's final message to Earth.

Revelation 13:16, 17 "And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name."

Question: Who did we say is this beast?

John said in Revelation 13:1 "I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy." We identified this beast power as the Papacy in Rome.

Verse 3 "I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death..."

The Roman general, Belsarius gave to the pope of Rome, religious and civil authority in 538 A.D., and the popes of Rome reigned supreme to 1798. Napoleon marched a portion of the French army under Berthier down into the city of Rome, Feb. 10, 1798, exactly 1260 years into the official Papal reign. Bible prophecy is precise.

Revelation 13:9, 10 "If any man have an ear, let him hear. He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints."

Revelation 13:3 "...and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast."

Paul gave us warning of the coming apostasy in 2 Thessalonians 2:8 "And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming.

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Time, Dec. 26, 1994 The stage is set!

Question: What is the stage set for?

Revelation 13:10 Establishes the timing of these prophecies. "He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints."

Revelation 13:11 "And I beheld <u>another</u> beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon."

Question: Who is this second beast?

There are Three questions we need to answer:

- 1) Where does this power arise?
- 2) When does this power arise?
- 3) How does this power arise?

Question 1: Where does this power arise?

Revelation 13:1 "I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy."

Revelation 17:15 "And ... the waters which thou sawest ... are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues." The first beast, the Papacy, arose from the center of civilization.

Revelation 13:11 "I beheld <u>another</u> beast <u>another</u> beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon."

Since the waters represent a densely populated area, then the earth would represent a sparsely populated land. The new beast comes up out of the earth or an unpopulated area.

Question: What does a woman symbolize in Bible prophecy?

2 Corinthians 11:2 "For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ." Jeremiah 6:2 "I have likened the daughter of Zion to a comely and delicate [woman]." (Also Ephesians 5:23-32; Revelation 12:1; 17:1-6; Isaiah 1:21)

So God's church is represented as a godly chaste virgin. While the great whore church of Revelations is represented as a corrupt woman.

Revelation 12:14 "And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent. The woman here is God's true church fleeing into the wilderness and the mountains for the period the Papacy is in power, 1,260 years.

Revelation 12:15 "And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a <u>flood</u> after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood." So the water as a flood is the multitude of the armies operating under Papal decree to pursue, persecute and kill God's people where ever they sought refuge.

Isaiah 59:19 "...When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him."

Revelation 12:15, 16 "And the earth helped the <u>woman</u>, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the <u>flood</u> which the dragon cast out of his mouth." With the new land, sparsely populated, many of God's people sought refuge across the sea.

Question 2: When does this power arise?

Revelation 13:9, 10 "If any man have an ear, let him hear. He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints." In 1798 the Papacy was taken captive and the first beast received the deadly wound.

Revelation 13:11 "And I beheld <u>another</u> beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon." So this new nation, the second beast was rising when the first beast was descending.

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Question 3: How does this power arise? Out of the earth.

- Two horns like a lamb not a beast of prey.
- The first beast has crowns.

- · Crowns represent kingly authority.
- There are no crowns on the horns of the second beast.
- The lack of crowns indicates freedom.
- Horns are a symbol of power. They indicate that this second beast derives its power from political and religious freedom.
- Lamb-like beast
 - 1) What power or nation was rising in 1798, when the papacy was going into captivity? The nation had already been born, like a lamb, but it would not become a mature power until a little later.
 - 2) It would arise in a sparsely populated area of the earth, compared to Europe, in a new location.
 - 3) It would a young nation and grow up quietly, into a powerful nation rather than simply conquer an existing powerful ruling kingdom, and would espouse Christ-like principles.
 - 4) It had no king represented to us in the fact that there were no crowns upon the horns. No kingly authority.
 - 5) It would rise to a position of worldwide power and influence.

Question: What is the only nation that fits this description?

The United States of America. Pilgrims came to America to escape religious tyranny. And God's faithful found refuge on these shores.

<u>Signs of the Times, June 3, 1889</u> When Wesley began his career in England, there were only a few who rallied around his standard. When the Puritans emigrated from England to <u>America</u>, they were like shipwrecked mariners who had barely escaped with their lives. Left without friends or influence, all they had was their precious faith, their strong will, and their earnest devotion to God. They were as sheep without a shepherd. The believers were few. Like the mustard seed, which is the least of all seeds, so seemed the Pilgrims; but their influence became powerful and far-reaching. The faith of the Puritans was as a coal from the altar of God, an inextinguishable light that glorified the land with its radiance... They were guided by the providence of God.

<u>The New World Compared With the Old, G.A. Townsend, p. 635</u> "...the mystery of her coming forth from vacancy... Like a silent seed we grew into an empire."

<u>Daniel and the Revelation</u>, <u>Uriah Smith</u>, <u>p. 578</u> "Emerging,,, amid the silence of the earth, adding daily to its power and strength."

<u>In the Constitution of the United States- First Amendment to the Constitution</u> - Congress shall make <u>no law</u> respecting an <u>establishment</u> of religion, or <u>prohibiting</u> the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press, or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

Congress shall make *no law* respecting an *establishment* of religion, or *prohibiting* the free exercise thereof;

In his book, <u>Rome Stoops to Conquer, pages 3 & 4</u> author E. Boyd Barrett wrote, "The present great campaign which the Pope is directing in person, the campaign to win America, is the churches supreme and final effort to regain her ancient preeminence in the world. For him (Pope Pius XI) our country is a battlefield on which is being waged the greatest struggle of the Church's history. The conquest of America is the supreme objective at which he aims. Pius is well aware that the Catholic Church can never hope to dominate the civilized world until America kneels, beaten and penitent, at her feet."

Rome Stoops to Conquer, pages 13 "Does the Church intend, should the powers be hers, to change and modify the Constitution? Does she mean to discard the American principle of the separation of Church and State? In fine, does she aim at being the established church of the United States? Revelation 13:11 "And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a <u>lamb</u>..." "...and he spake as a <u>dragon</u>."

Question: What are the characteristics of a dragon-like beast speaking?

Revelation 13:2 "... the dragon gave him his power, and his <u>SEAT</u>, and great authority."

Revelation 13:2 "... the dragon gave him his POWER, and his seat, and GREAT AUTHORITY."

Question: How does a nation speak?

A nation speaks through the action of its legislative and judicial authorities.

Question: What is the "image of the beast"? An image is a "likeness of".

Revelation 13:12 "And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed."

Revelation 13:16 "And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads."

God respects human freedom.

Revelation 22:17 "...And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely."

Joshua 24:15 " And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve...

Once again, the issues revolve around **WORSHIP.** Worship the Creator – Revelation 14:7 or worship the beast – Revelation 13:4. If you don't worship the Creator, or if you don't worship at all, you worship the beast by default.

Question: What does the Roman Catholic church claim is the sign of its authority? We covered this thoroughly in our last lesson.

<u>Catholic Record</u>, <u>Sept. 1, 1923</u> - "The church is above the Bible, and this <u>transference of Sabbath observance</u> Is proof of that fact."

<u>C. F. Thomas</u>, Chancellor of Cardinal Gibbons, Nov. 11, 1895 "Of course the Catholic church claims that the change was her act. And the act is a <u>mark of her ecclesiastical power and authority</u> in religious matters."

Question: Are Protestant leaders calling for legislation to enforce the papacy's mark of authority?

<u>Christianity Today</u>, <u>Harold Lindsell (editor)</u>, <u>May 7, 1976</u> "All businesses, including gasoline stations and restaurants, should close every Sunday by force of legislation fiat through the duly elected officials of the people."

<u>Jerry Falwell</u> "All Americans would do well to petition the President and the Congress to make a federal law, and an amendment to the Constitution if need be, to establish the Sabbath as a National Day of Rest."

Church and state will unite to enforce religious practices. Prophecy has never failed, nor will it.

<u>Blinded by Might</u>, Ed Dobson - "Whenever the church cozies up to political power, it losses sight of its all-important mission to change the world from the inside out," writes Thomas. We urge Anglicans and Roman Catholics to explore together how the ministry of the Bishop of Rome might be offered and received in order to assist our Communions to grow towards full, ecclesial communion."

Question: What does Bible prophecy reveal?

Revelation 13:11, 12 "And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon. And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and <u>causeth</u> the earth and them which dwell therein to <u>worship</u> the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed."

<u>Washington Post</u>, 1-8-01, p. A-19 (Jim Wallis) - "When the phone call came from Austin, I was surprised. Just two days after his election was assured, President-elect Bush wanted a meeting with religious leaders to discuss faith- based initiatives in solving poverty... Bush asked theological questions such as, "What is justice?'.... We [the religious leaders] told him that in <u>forging new partnerships</u> to reduce poverty, the religious community will not only be service providers but <u>prophetic interrogators</u>.

Question: What does the Roman Catholic church claim is the sign of its authority?

The central issue regarding the mark of the beast is WORSHIP.

No one will receive the mark of the beast until religious legislation is passed enforcing the counterfeit Sabbath.

Question: Who is actually being worshipped through the beast power?

Revelation 13:4 "And they worshipped the <u>DRAGON</u> which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast..." Satan is the one who is actually receiving the worship.

Question: Does the Bible reveal the method Satan will use in these last days?

Revelation 13:13, 14 "And he doeth great wonders, so that he maketh fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men, And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; ..."

Numerous articles have been written about miracles in the Catholic Church all over the world.

Revelation 13:3 "And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast."

Exodus 23:2 "Thou shalt not follow a multitude to do evil; neither shalt thou speak in a cause to decline after many to wrest judgment."

John 16:2 "They shall put you out of the synagogues: yea, the time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service."

Matthew 7:21-23 "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Question: What will prevent God's end-time people from being deceived?

Isaiah 8:20 "To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them.

Present Truth for this time is the three angels messages of Revelation 14.

Revelation 14:6, 7 "And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

The issues revolve around:

1. The authority of God's Word. 2. Loyalty to Christ. 3. Obedience to His Commandments.

Matthew 16:26 "For what is a man profited, if he gain the whole world, and lose your own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

Throughout the dark ages, many millions of Christian martyrs were willing to die for their faith — many burned at the stake over disagreeing with the Roman Church of the Dark Ages over the nature of the communion "host" (bread).

The church said it became the actual body of Christ, changed from ordinary bread by the power of the priest, or was it simply a symbol of such, for the faithful to remember Christ by? Many could have had their lives spared by compromising their faith in this "little" particular, and only agree with the church authorities but chose rather to be faithful in all things and in doing so also chose death.
